Text of Motion: Resolution No. 408 – Approving The Execution Of A Contract In

Excess Of \$50,000.00 Entered Into By The County – Health Alliance Hospital - Department Of Mental Health – Department Of Mental

Health

Discussion: This resolution is for an outpatient methadone maintenance treatment

program. The hospital is the only local entity in the county licensed and certified by New York State to run this program. Health Alliance is the sole source approved by the state in our area. Program subsidy to Health Alliance is \$100K. Legislator Belfiglio noted the hours of operation are not listed in the contract. Ken Crannell noted this is a highly regulated program which requires state approval by OASIS in order to make any change to the program. Health Alliance has agreed to add an additional half day if OASIS grants approval. An additional half day over the weekend – on a Sunday will cost \$45K where 20-25 people will benefit. Ideally Mr. Crannell noted the goal should be to expand the base of the program to 250 slots and eliminate the wait list - not add another day. Our neighboring county also has a program. Health Alliance - not the county applies for the program change request with OASIS. The 2016 budget doesn't include funding for the additional service forcing a cutback somewhere internally. County representatives have met with Health Alliance to expedite the process. Counsel Guerin recommended the committee pass the resolution preventing disruption of service.
