

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement, And Any Amendments Thereto, With The New York State Division Of Homeland Security And Emergency Services For Participation In The 2016-2017 Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) Operations Grant – Emergency Communications / Emergency Management

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Emergency Communications / Emergency Management; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Communications / Emergency Management has received notification from the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services regarding the 2016-2017 Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) Operations Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Communications / Emergency Management requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to enter into an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services for the contract period from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017, in the amount of \$155,526.00; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this program is to sustain ongoing operations and improvements of public safety answering points; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services for participation in the 2016-2017 Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) Operations Grant, in the amount of \$155,526.00, as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature, and the Chairman and Deputy Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee; and be it further
