

Approving The Execution Of A Contract Amendment For \$22,280.00, Causing The Aggregate Contract Plus Amendment Amount To Be In Excess Of \$50,000.00 Entered Into By The County – Eastern Heating & Cooling, Inc. – Department Of Public Works

WHEREAS, a contract amendment for execution by the County with Eastern Heating & Cooling, Inc. has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:
