Approving The Execution Of A Contract Amendment For \$131,445.00 Entered Into By The County – Youth Advocate Programs, Inc. – Department Of Social Services

Chairman of the Health, Human Services and Human Rights Committee, Abe Uchitelle, and Deputy Chair Craig V. Lopez offer the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-11(O) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A2-5(15) of the Administrative Code, the Ulster County Legislature shall have the power to approve the execution of certain contracts and amendments in the amount of \$50,000.00 or in excess of \$50,000.00 entered into by the County; and

WHEREAS, a contract amendment for execution by the County with Youth Advocate Programs, Inc. has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:
