

Amending The 2022 Ulster County Budget To Accept An Allocation Of Funds From The New York State Office Of Prevention Of Domestic Violence – Department Of Probation

Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee, Abe Uchitelle, and Deputy Chair Gina Hansut offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted at the request of the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Probation; and

WHEREAS, the department has received notification from the New York State Office for Prevention of Domestic Violence (OPDV) for an award from the Pandemic Emergency Assistance Fund to the Ulster County Crime Victim Assistance Program, Department of Probation; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Probation administers the Crime Victim Assistance Program (CVAP), which aids victims and witnesses of crime; and

WHEREAS, the funding will provide eligible domestic violence survivors in Ulster County (and their children) with short term, non-recurrent expenses related to housing and essential needs; and

WHEREAS, in order to reflect the increased funding an amendment of the 2022 budget is necessary; and

WHEREAS, no County contribution or matching funding is required; and

WHEREAS, the County has received notification, dated March 7, 2022, that the final award of \$187,723, is greater than was anticipated as of the date this resolution was submitted for consideration; now, therefore, be it
