

**Resolution No. 174      April 21, 2015**

**Approving The Execution Of A Contract In Excess Of \$50,000.00 Entered Into By The County – Eileen Sandler – Department Of Social Services**

Chairman of the Public Health and Social Services Committee, Craig V. Lopez, and Deputy Chairman Jeanette Provenzano offer the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-11(O) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A2-5(15) of the Administrative Code, the Ulster County Legislature shall have the power to approve the execution of certain contracts and amendments in the amount of \$50,000.00 or in excess of \$50,000.00 entered into by the County; and

WHEREAS, a contract for execution by the County with Eileen Sandler has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:

The services provided are regulated by NYS, paid in accordance with NYS set rates, & providers are licensed & approved through NYS.
