The County Historian shall preserve, interpret and promote the history of Ulster County and shall have all the powers and perform all the duties conferred or imposed by applicable law.”*; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has appointed Geoffrey Miller as Ulster County’s Historian; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby confirms the appointment of Geoffrey Miller as Ulster County’s Historian,
