

**Amending The 2025 Ulster County Operating Budget – Establishing Capital Project No. 726 – 2025 Pavement Preservation Of Various Roads – Amending The 2025 Capital Fund Budget – Department Of Public Works (Highways And Bridges)**

Chair of the Public Works and Capital Projects Committee, Kathy Nolan, and Deputy Chair Herbert Litts, III offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted at the request of the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the approved 2025 – 2030 Capital Improvement Program includes a project entitled, “Pavement Preservation of Various Roads” totaling \$650,000.00 for fiscal year 2025, to extend service life; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works requests that Capital Project No. 726 be established and funded; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, based upon examination by the Ulster County Legislature, the County’s funding of this Project constitutes a Type II action as defined under Sections 4.5.6 of the County of Ulster’s State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Type II List, which was adopted pursuant to Resolution No. 118 dated April 20, 2010; and, be it further

RESOLVED, Ulster County has determined that this funding action does not pose a significant potential environmental impact and may be progressed as a Type II action in accordance with 6 NYCRR Part 617 of SEQRA, and does not require any further determination or procedure under SEQRA; and, be it further
