

**Confirming Appointment Of Tyrone E. Wilson As Ulster County Commissioner Of Human Rights**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections C-25 (A) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A3-4 (A) of the Administrative Code, the County Executive has the power and duty to appoint department heads; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-100 of the Ulster County Charter and Section A30-1(A) of the Administrative Code: *“There shall be a Commission of Human Rights headed by a Commissioner of Human Rights who shall be appointed by the County Executive, subject to confirmation of the Legislature, and serve at his or her pleasure,”* and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has appointed Tyrone E. Wilson as the Ulster County Commissioner of Human Rights; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Ulster County Legislature hereby confirms the appointment of Tyrone E. Wilson as the Ulster County Commissioner of Human Rights,  
and moves its adoption.
