WHEREAS, the term of the agreement shall be July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to sign an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the BOCES School District to provide a Deputy Sheriff to serve as a School Resource Officer for the term July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney and Chair of the Legislature,

and move its adoption.
