

Amending Resolution No. 335 Of 2016, Establishing Capital Project No. 481, Technology Facility Upgrade– SUNY Ulster

Chairman of the Public Works and Capital Projects Committee, Dean J. Fabiano, and Deputy Chairman Peter M. Loughran offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of Ulster County Community College; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 335 established Capital Project No. 481 – Technology Facility Upgrade – SUNY Ulster in the amount of \$300,000, with the following funding delineations, \$150,000.00 SUNY funding, and \$150,000.00 Ulster County funding; and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Community College Foundation has indicated that it will contribute \$100,000.00 in funding for this project; and

WHEREAS, at the request of the State University of New York (SUNY) an amendment to this funding split is required, the original project total of \$300,000.00 will not increase but the funding is further delineated as follows: \$150,000.00 SUNY; \$100,000.00 Ulster County Community College Foundation and \$50,000.00 Ulster County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees approved Resolution #17-4-206 approving the amendment of the funding split of Capital Project No. as indicated above, for the purchase and replacement of technology at SUNY Ulster’s campus; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 335 of 2016 and Capital Project No. 481-SUNY Ulster Technology Facility Upgrade is hereby amended, to reflect the following funding delineation \$150,000.00 SUNY; \$100,000.00 Ulster County Community College Foundation and \$50,000.00 Ulster County,

and move its adoption.
