WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted at the request of the County Executive on behalf of the Departments of Planning and Public Works; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No 480 of September 2023, the County established Capital Project No. 677 Golden Hill Transportation Improvements and included funding for the design of gate and signal on Golden Hill for improvements needed to support the Golden Hill Housing Development and improve safety for access to County facilities as well as address traffic concerns associated with access from adjoining neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, in collaboration with the City of Kingston the County has developed concept designs for the signal to be located at the intersection of Golden Hill Drive and Route 32; and

WHEREAS, the preferred concept requires the elimination of the right turn lane into Golden Hill as well as removal of the existing median on Golden Hill Drive thereby requiring additional design work beyond the proposed signal; and

WHEREAS, Ulster County has received a proposal from Creighton Manning Engineering for this additional design work; and

WHEREAS, the County Ulster County issued as Request For Bid (RFB) in January of 2024 for traffic control device installation work on the Golden Hill Traffic Control Gate; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, based upon examination by the Ulster County Legislature, the County's funding of this Project constitutes a Type II action as defined under Section 4.5.4 of the County of Ulster's State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Type II List, which was adopted pursuant to Resolution No. 118 dated April 20, 2010; and, be it further
