WHEREAS, updating this policy will ensure that UCAT is in compliance with all Federal and State regulations that are required for continuing to receive funding from both Federal and State funding sources; and

WHEREAS, establishing an updated substance abuse policy will ensure that the rules for compliance with our funding opportunities and driver programs are consistently enforced and will help maintain and enhance the County's reputation in running a safe transit system; now, therefore be it
