Approving The Exercise Of An Option To Extend The Primary Term Of The Lease Agreement With Spring Lake Fire Department For The Ulster County Central Auto Garage – Department of Public Works (Buildings & Grounds)

Chairman of the Public Works and Capital Projects Committee, Dean J. Fabiano, and Deputy Chairman John Parete offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution was submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Public Works (Buildings and Grounds); and

WHEREAS, the County currently leases space at 125 Maxwell Lane, Kingston, for use as the Central Auto Garage from the Spring Lake Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Lease provides the County with the right and the option to extend the primary term of the Lease for a renewal term of five (5) years, at a cost to be determined by applying the Consumer Price Index formula, which results in a an annual rent of \$26,724.77; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has requested that the Legislature approve exercising the option to extend the primary term of the Lease, which extension would commence on September 15, 2013 and end on September 14, 2018; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby approves exercising the option to extend the primary term of the Lease with the Spring Lake Fire Department for Ulster County Central Auto Garage located at 125 Maxwell Lane, Kingston, NY, for a renewal term of five (5) years, commencing September 15, 2013 and ending September 14, 2018, at an annual rental cost of \$26,724.77, and authorize the Chairman of the Legislature to sign the same, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that pursuant to the terms of the Lease, the County of Ulster shall have the option to terminate the Lease for any reason or no reason, upon ninety days written notice to the Landlord,

and moves its adoption.
