WHEREAS, this resolution is requesting authorization to apply for the Department of Justice BJA FY 2022 Body-worn Camera Policy and Implementation Program Grant; and

WHEREAS, Capital Project No. 616 was established pursuant to Resolution No. 53 dated February 15, 2022, in the amount of \$588,535.00 to purchase Axon Body Cameras; and

WHEREAS, the approval to apply for this grant will provide the Sheriff's Office an opportunity to expand the comprehensive body-worn camera programs with a specific and demonstrated plan to implement this technology to maximize the benefits of BWCs, while furthering the DOJ's mission by promoting the safe and fair administration of justice; and

WHEREAS, this program requires a 50% match of expended funds; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to apply for this grant by May 25, 2022, or risk losing this opportunity; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby approves the application for the Department of Justice BJA FY 2022 Body-worn Camera Policy and Implementation Program Grant, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified and approved by the County Attorney,
