WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Emergency Communications / Emergency Management; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Emergency Communications/Emergency Management was previously awarded a grant from the New York Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services in the amount of \$978,000.00 for the purpose of enhancing the interoperability of communications; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of a VHF high band paging system is planned and is within the scope of the grant; and

WHEREAS, to date, the Department of Emergency Communications/Emergency Management spent \$0.00 of the \$978,000.00 leaving an unexpended balance of \$978,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the unexpended balance was not included in the 2014 Ulster County Budget, and a budget modification is necessary to appropriate the necessary funds; now, therefore be it
