

**Approving The Execution Of A Contract Amendment For \$67,410.00 Entered Into By The County – Bergmann Associates, Architects, Engineers, Landscape Architects & Surveyors, D.P.C. – Department Of Public Works**

WHEREAS, a contract amendment for execution by the County with Bergmann Associates, Architects, Engineers, Landscape Architects & Surveyors, D.P.C. has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:
