

**Approving The Execution Of A Contract Amendment For \$571,650.00 Entered Into By The County – Urbahn Architects PLLC – Department Of Public Works**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-11(O) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A2-5(15) of the Administrative Code, the Ulster County Legislature shall have the power to approve the execution of certain contracts and amendments in the amount of \$50,000.00 or in excess of \$50,000.00 entered into by the County; and

WHEREAS, a contract amendment for execution by the County with Urbahn Architects PLLC has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:

2021-529 - Amd #3 - expand the scope of services to accommodate the costs associated with increased building costs, time extension, escalated labor, and additional site analysis - comprehensive full phase architectural, engineering and/or consulting services for design and site selection for the Ulster County Public Safety Communications Building to include the Ulster County Emergency Operations Center ("EOC")/Government Operations Center ("GOC"), all the divisions of the Ulster County Department of Emergency Services, and the County's Public Safety Answering Point ("PSAP") - Capital Project	100% County	RFP	Prior Term 11/1/21 - 9/30/25 Amd Term 7/1/24 - 2/28/27	Prior Amt \$1,087,930.00 Amd Amt \$571,650.00 Total Amt \$1,659,580.00
