

**Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute A Contract With The New York State Department Of Health To Participate In The Childhood Lead Poisoning Primary Prevention Program – Department Of Health**

Chairman of the Public Health and Social Services Committee, Craig V. Lopez, and Deputy Chairman Jeanette Provenzano offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Health; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Health requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a contract (Contract No. C030262), and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Department of Health to participate in the Childhood Lead Poisoning Primary Prevention Program, for the period April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2020, in the amount of \$1,408,610; and

WHEREAS, funding will be used to support and enhance local efforts to target multi-family, non-owner-occupied, pre-1978 dwellings in the City of Kingston where children ages six and under reside; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish the program's objectives, community partnerships will be developed, and these partners will provide public outreach and education and assist in identifying residents who may qualify for risk assessments for lead; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is authorized to execute a contract (Contract No. C030262), and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Department of Health to participate in the Childhood Lead Poisoning Primary Prevention Program, for the period April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2020, in the amount of \$1,408,610, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, if funding for this program is eliminated, the program will be eliminated as well,

and move its adoption.
