WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the Sheriff’s Office; and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff has secured a public protection grant in the amount of \$5,000 from New York State Senator George Amedore, funded by the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used to purchase hard case tourniquets for each member to wear on their duty belts; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to increase the Ulster County Sheriff’s Budget to reflect such grant; now, therefore be it;
