WHEREAS, the County of Ulster, through its Sheriff's Office will be reimbursed by Ulster County BOCES in the amount of \$117,600.78 for the term 7/1/24-12/31/24 and \$117,600.79 for the term 1/1/2025-6/30/2025, for a term of one (1) year, not-to-exceed \$235,201.57 for the term of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the term of the agreement shall be July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to sign an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with Ulster County BOCES to provide two Deputy Sheriffs to serve as School Resource Officers for the term July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the U rney,
