

**Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement With The Rondout Valley Central School District To Provide Two Deputy Sheriffs As School Resource Officers – Ulster County Sheriff**

WHEREAS, the Rondout Valley Central School District has requested two (2) Deputy Sheriffs be assigned as School Resource Officers (SROs) at locations as requested by the District; and

WHEREAS, the Rondout Valley Central School District will pay Ulster County an amount not less than \$168,045.70 for the services of the two full-time Deputy Sheriffs assigned as the School Resource Officers; and

WHEREAS, the term of the agreement shall be September 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to sign an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the Rondout Valley Central School District to provide two (2) Deputy Sheriffs to serve as School Resource Officers for the term September 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, Counsel to the Legislature, and Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature,

and moves its adoption.
