

Approving The Execution Of A Contract For \$3,060,930.75 Entered Into By The County – Arold Construction Company, Inc. – Department Of Public Works

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-11(O) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A2-5(15) of the Administrative Code, the Ulster County Legislature shall have the power to approve the execution of certain contracts and amendments in the amount of \$50,000.00 or in excess of \$50,000.00 entered into by the County; and

WHEREAS, a contract for execution by the County with Arold Construction Company, Inc. has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:

2023-146 - construction services for a 1.8 mile asphalt multi-use path in connection with the Kingston Rail Trail to be located on the former O&W railroad alignment from Washington Avenue to the O&W Rail Trail adjacent to New York State Route 209 in the Town of Hurley (Federal Aid Project - PIN 8758.04) - Capital Project	67% Federal 17% State 16% County	Bid	2/17/23 - 1/16/24	\$3,060,930.75
