WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted at the request of the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Mental Health; and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Department of Mental Health has received notification from the New York State Office of Mental Health (OMH) for increased funding for a stipend increase for Supported Housing beds and for funding for the Legislative Add: Veteran P2P Pilot program as per OMH State Aid letter dated March 21, 2022; and

WHEREAS, in order to reflect the increased funding, an amendment of the 2022 budget is necessary; and

WHEREAS, there is no increase in County Contribution as a result of these modifications; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby approves the contract amendment with New York State Office of Mental Health (OMH) for increased funding for a stipend increase for Supported Housing beds and for funding for the Legislative Add: Veteran P2P Pilot program as per OMH State Aid letter dated March 21, 2022; and, be it further
