WHEREAS, in order to have an experienced person to fill this role and remain competitive in hiring, it is therefore necessary to increase the annual salary of the Director of Tourism from a 2020 annual salary of \$80,219.00 to a 2020 annual salary of \$100,630.00; now, therefore be it
