RESOLVED, that any honorably discharged member of the armed forces of the United States shall pay a discounted fare between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., and such discount shall be fifty percent (50%) of the full fare for the service provided upon the presentation of an Ulster County Veterans identification card or an official United States military identification card,
