WHEREAS, the project expenditures in the amount of \$150,000.00 for the New Salem Road Stabilization, were approved in the 2021 - 2026 Capital Program; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works requests that Capital Project No. 606 be established and funded for materials; now, therefore be it
