WHEREAS, the funds will be used exclusively to continue and enhance the services offered to victims and witnesses of crime in Ulster County provided by CVAP; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute contract OVS01-C00009GM-1080200, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Office of Victim Services in the amount of \$1,881,015.00 for the term October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2028, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney and Legislative Counsel,
