WHEREAS, Resolution No. 525 of 2018 approved the advancement of capital projects for the Ulster County Community College that were included in the approved 2019-2024 Ulster County Capital Improvement program; and

WHEREAS, the roof of the Kingston Center of SUNY Ulster, located at 94 Mary’s Avenue in Kingston, is in need of the safety platform and railing for OSHA compliance; and

WHEREAS, the 2019-2024 Capital Improvement Program included funding of \$90,000.00 for the Kingston Center Roof Railing Construction; and

WHEREAS, SUNY Ulster Board of Trustees approved Resolution No. 19-9-167 establishing Capital Project: Kingston Center Roof Safety Improvement in the amount of \$90,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the \$90,000.00 cost to construct Kingston Center Roof Safety Improvement, would be divided as follows: \$45,000.00 State and \$45,000.00 Ulster County; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that Capital Project No. 552 – SUNY Ulster – Kingston Center Roof Safety Improvement is hereby established as follows:
