**Approving The Execution Of A Contract Amendment For Rates Anticipated To Exceed \$50,000.00 Entered Into By The County – Birnie Bus Services Inc. – Department Of Social Services**

WHEREAS, a contract amendment for execution by the County with Birnie Bus Services Inc. has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:
