WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Emergency Services Division of Fire Services; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services has received notification from the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services regarding the 2018-2019 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness (HMEP) Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this program is to sustain specialized training for the Ulster County HAZMAT Team; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to enter into an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services for the contract period beginning October 1, 2018 and ending September 30, 2019 in the amount of \$5,150.00; now, therefore, be it
