

Approving And Executing A One-Year Extension Of The Collective Bargaining Agreement Between The County Of Ulster And The Ulster County Community College Faculty Association

Chairman of the Legislative Programs, Education and Community Services Committee, David B. Donaldson, and Deputy Chair Heidi Haynes, offer the following:

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Community College labor attorney William Wallens and members of the executive staff have negotiated a one-year extension of the collective bargaining agreement with the Ulster County Community College Faculty Association beginning September 1, 2018 and ending August 31, 2019, and recommend the agreement to the College's Board of Trustees and the Ulster County Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the President recommends affirmative action by the Board of Trustees on the one-year extension of the collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, the one-year extension of the collective bargaining agreement has been reviewed and adopted by the College's Board of Trustees pursuant to Resolution #18-6-133 dated June 27, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the changes to the collective bargaining agreement incorporated into the one-year extension, include a two (2) percent increase in salaries for both full-time faculty and adjunct faculty, as well as a two (2) percent increase in the full-time faculty overload rates; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby approves the one-year extension of the collective bargaining agreement between the County of Ulster and the Faculty Association beginning September 1, 2018 and ending August 31, 2019; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive of the County of Ulster is hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Agreement with the Ulster County Community College Faculty Association as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and move its adoption.
