

Resolution No. 574 November 15, 2022

Approving The Execution Of A Contract For \$390,000.00 Entered Into By The County – Access: Supports For Living Inc. – Department Of Mental Health

Chair of the Health, Human Services and Housing Committee, Eve Walter, and Deputy Chair Craig V. Lopez offer the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-11(O) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A2-5(15) of the Administrative Code, the Ulster County Legislature shall have the power to approve the execution of certain contracts and amendments in the amount of \$50,000.00 or in excess of \$50,000.00 entered into by the County; and

WHEREAS, a contract for execution by the County with Access: Supports for Living Inc. has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:

2023-94 - provide expanded mobile mental health services including: a. performing acute telephonic behavioral health assessments for individuals in crisis that contact the Ulster County Department of Emergency Services' 911 Center. b. expand the hours of operations for the existing Mobile Mental Health team by two (2) hours, five (5) days per week. c. expand existing operations by adding an additional team of two (2) in New Paltz eight (8) hours per day five (5) days per week	100% County	Professional Services	1/1/23 - 12/31/23	\$390,000.00
