Approving The Execution Of A Contract For \$150,000.00 Entered Into By The County – Ulster County Community Action Committee, Inc. – Department Of Social Services

Chair of the Health, Human Services and Housing Committee, Eve Walter, and Deputy Chair Craig V. Lopez offer the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-11(O) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A2-5(15) of the Administrative Code, the Ulster County Legislature shall have the power to approve the execution of certain contracts and amendments in the amount of \$50,000.00 or in excess of \$50,000.00 entered into by the County; and

WHEREAS, a contract for execution by the County with Ulster County Community Action Committee, Inc. has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:

2023-42 - provide supportive services to families and individuals placed in temporary housing at various hotels and motels throughout Ulster County, as well as hotels and motels outside of the geographic boundaries of Ulster County.
