

Approving The Execution Of A Contract Amendment For \$155,000.00 Entered Into By The County – Family of Woodstock Inc. – Department of Social Services

Chairman of the Health, Human Services and Housing Committee, Abe Uchitelle, and Deputy Chair Craig V. Lopez offer the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-11(O) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A2-5(15) of the Administrative Code, the Ulster County Legislature shall have the power to approve the execution of certain contracts and amendments in the amount of \$50,000.00 or in excess of \$50,000.00 entered into by the County; and

WHEREAS, a contract amendment for execution by the County with Family of Woodstock Inc. has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:

2023-27 - Amd #1 - increase the not-to-exceed amount for operation of two (2) homeless shelters as follows: a. The Darmstadt Residence, a nineteen (19) bed shelter located at 40 Thomas Street, Kingston, New York, which provides emergency housing and related Services for individual adults who are age eighteen (18) or older and does not accommodate children. b.
