

**Resolution No. 649      December 17, 2024**

**Rescinding Resolution No. 517 Of 2024, And Approving The Execution Of A Contract For \$800,000.00, Entered Into By The County – La Salle School – Department Of Mental Health**

Referred to: The Health, Human Services and Housing Committee (Chairman Uchitelle and Legislators Collins, Corcoran, Harmon, Kitchen, Lopez, and McCollough), and The Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Gavaris and Legislators Collins, Hansut, Kovacs, Nolan, and Roberts)

Chairman of the Health, Human Services and Housing Committee, Abe Uchitelle, and Deputy Chair Craig V. Lopez offer the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-11(O) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A2-5(15) of the Administrative Code, the Ulster County Legislature shall have the power to approve the execution of certain contracts and amendments in the amount of \$50,000.00 or in excess of \$50,000.00 entered into by the County; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 517 of 2024 approved a contract with La Salle School for \$1,018,411.00 for behavioral health programming embedded within Ulster County School districts; and

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned contract has not yet been executed, and a revised contract with La Salle School has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:

2025-20 - Behavioral health programming embedded within Ulster County School districts - originally approved via Resolution 517 of 2024, prior to execution, amount has been reduced from \$1,018,411.00 and funding source changed from 100% County	26% State 74% County	Professional Services	1/1/25 - 12/31/25	\$800,000.00
