

**Approving The Execution Of A Contract Amendment For \$365,499.75 Entered Into By The County – Urbahn Architects PLLC – Department Of Public Works**

Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee, Abe Uchitelle, and Deputy Chair Gina Hansut offer the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-11(O) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A2-5(15) of the Administrative Code, the Ulster County Legislature shall have the power to approve the execution of certain contracts and amendments in the amount of \$50,000.00 or in excess of \$50,000.00 entered into by the County; and

WHEREAS, a contract amendment for execution by the County with Urbahn Architects PLLC has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:

2021-529 - Amd #1 - expand the additional services to provide review of up to six (6) additional potential site locations, bringing the total number of potential locations to twelve (12), expand the additional services to provide additional environmental services and extend the Contract Completion date for comprehensive full phase architectural, engineering and/or consulting services for design and site selection for the Ulster County Public Safety Communications Building to include the Ulster County Emergency Operations Center ("EOC")/Government Operations Center ("GOC"), all the divisions of the Ulster County Department of Emergency Services, and the County's Public Safety Answering Point ("PSAP")	100% County	RFP	Prior Term 11/1/21 - 6/30/24 Amd Term 1/1/23 - 9/30/25	Prior Amt \$722,430.25 Amd Amt \$365,499.75 Total Amt \$1,087,930.00
