

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Inter-Municipal Agreement With The State Of New York Division Of Homeland Security And Emergency Services For Interoperable Communications Resources (Mutualink) – Department Of Emergency Communications / Emergency Management

Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee, Thomas J. Briggs, and Deputy Chairman Ronald G. Lapp, Jr. offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Emergency Communications / Emergency Management; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Communications / Emergency Management has received notification from the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services regarding the loan of Interoperable Communications Resources (Mutualink); and

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Communications / Emergency Management requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to enter into an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services for a one year contract period, in order to receive a loan of Interoperable Communications Resources at no cost to the County; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this program is to allow counties to communicate on a common platform for emergency management and public safety planning and response purposes; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services which hereby grants a temporary revocable permit to the County, to use the subject Interoperable Communications Resources, according to the terms and conditions of the Agreement, and any further amendments to the Agreement, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney in consultation with the Chairman of the Legislature and the Chairman and Deputy Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee,
