

Resolution No. 712 December 18, 2023

Approving The Execution Of A Contract For \$123,341.00 Entered Into By The County – Family Of Woodstock Inc. – Department Of Probation

Referred to: The Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee (Chairwoman Hansut and Legislators Bowen, Fabiano, Hewitt, and Lopez), and The Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Gavaris and Legislators Cahill, Criswell, Roberts, and Ronk)

Chairwoman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee, Gina Hansut, and Deputy Chair Chris Hewitt offer the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-11(O) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A2-5(15) of the Administrative Code, the Ulster County Legislature shall have the power to approve the execution of certain contracts and amendments in the amount of \$50,000.00 or in excess of \$50,000.00 entered into by the County; and

WHEREAS, a contract for execution by the County with Family of Woodstock Inc. has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:

2024-109 - operation and implementation of the Alternative to Juvenile Detention program, which provides Restorative Justice services for youth ages seven (7) through seventeen (17) years old with Juvenile Delinquency or Adolescent Offender behavior, or behavior that could result in a Violation of Probation, and as needed case management for young adults ages eighteen (18) through twenty-six (26) (referred by the District Attorney) with criminal court matters or behavior that could lead to a Violation of Probation	100% County	RFP	1/1/24 - 12/31/24	\$123,341.00
