

Resolution No. 730 December 18, 2023

Approving The Execution Of A Contract Amendment For \$2,697.00, Causing The Aggregate Contract Plus Amendment Amount To Be In Excess Of \$50,000.00, Entered Into By The County – Rehabilitation Support Services, Inc. – Department Of Mental Health

WHEREAS, a contract for execution by the County with Rehabilitation Support Services, Inc. has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:
