Chair Bartels will call upon Vice Chair Peter Criswell, District 7, to present a Proclamation on behalf of Ulster County to Berrie Sattler and Alex from The Trans Closet of the Hudson Valley in celebration of their work and declaring June as Pride Month in Ulster County.

Formed in 2018, The Trans Closet of the Hudson Valley is a mutual aid project “for and by members of the local trans community providing clothes, gender-affirming supplies, and other resources without question or cost.” Focused on ending the stigma and stress associated with clothes shopping for transgender and nonbinary individuals, TCHV is structured as a thrift shop where everything is free, and where trans people can experience a safe space to explore gender expression in a welcoming setting. TCHV also provides supports and connections for trans and non-binary individuals and promotes the work of other 2SLGBTQIA+ justice organizations in the Hudson Valley.
