Formed in 2018, The Trans Closet of the Hudson Valley is a mutual aid project "for and by members of the local trans community providing clothes, gender-affirming supplies, and other resources without question or cost." Focused on ending the stigma and stress associated with clothes shopping for transgender and nonbinary individuals, TCHV is structured as a thrift shop where everything is free, and where trans people can experience a safe space to explore gender expression in a welcoming setting. TCHV also provides supports and connections for trans and non-binary individuals and promotes the work of other 2SLGBTQIA+ justice organizations in the Hudson Valley.
