PUBLIC COMMENT:

There was (1) speaker signed up for public comment.

1. <u>Meg Carey, Glenford, NY</u>: Ms. Carey talked about the need for rail banking experts to evaluate the 38 mile U&D Corridor. Ms. Carey noted from the beginning the county's stated goal has been to develop a connected trail from Poughkeepsie to Highmount. If a side deal is reached with the DEP, without knowing if rail banking is possible for the entire corridor, then the connected trail plan could be at risk. Without federal rail banking in place, Ms. Carey believes it's likely that the more than 30 private property owners along the corridor may sue to regain control of their land once any tracks are removed. Ms. Carey concluded it would be miserable for the county to end up with the heart of the railroad ripped out and at the same time no possibility of a connected trail from Poughkeepsie to Highmount.
