SUNY Ulster Presents \$28 Million Budget to Ulster County Legislature County Contribution Expected to Remain Level

SUNY Ulster President Dr. Alan P. Roberts presented the College's 2019-20 budget totaling \$28,442,674 to the Ulster County Legislature, calling for a \$200 increase in full-time tuition and \$10 increase in part-time tuition per credit hour for the 2019-20 academic year with level funding from the County of Ulster, in a budget workshop held on the Stone Ridge campus this evening.

The College's 2019-2020 proposed operating revenue is projected to be \$24,942,674, a \$106,437 increase over the approved 2018-2019 College budget. The requested contribution from the County of Ulster will remain at \$6,400,863. The FY 2019 Enacted Budget increases base operating aid for SUNY community colleges at \$2,947 per full time equivalent student. State aid comprises 25 percent of the College's operating budget, while the County's contribution comprises 26 percent and tuition accounts for 35 percent in the proposed budget. The remainder of the budget is comprised of fees and other revenues.

Additionally, the budget is predicated on funding for capital projects from the County of Ulster and the State University of New York, as well as requests to the Ulster Community College Foundation for technology upgrades and support for miscellaneous programming.

Projected enrollment for 2019-20 is 2,026 FTEs, a decrease of 73 FTEs as compared to the 2018-2019 budget.

President Dr. Roberts said, he is optimistic that new opportunities, enhanced partnerships, and thinking differently will assist SUNY Ulster in continuing to build enrollment while serving and meeting the needs of our students. "Since 2015, SUNY Ulster is one of two community colleges in New York State with growth in enrollment by 2%. Focusing on our mission of changing lives by providing affordable access to higher education, we are making SUNY Ulster an even better and stronger

institution positioned to weather the challenges ahead and poised to ensure its mission endures to serve the County and Hudson Valley region."

The budget will be considered for approval by the Ulster County Legislature on June 18.
