Deputy County Executive Ken Crannell offered the committee a tour of the Mental Health Department services – date and time to be determined.

Legislator Chris Allen praised Legislator Mary Wawro for her efforts putting together a free community Narcan Training in Saugerties a few weeks back. Legislator's Allen, Wawro and Fabiano, in addition to approx. three dozen others attended and are now certified in New York State to administer the drug to reverse the effects of an opioid overdose. Dr. Raymond Harvey was the sponsor through the New York Anti-Narcotics Coalition who provided training. Legislator Belfiglio noted Dr. Harvey is an Ulster County resident, a member of the UCAN committee, and will be holding another free training on July 14th at the Esopus Town Hall. Sixty seven people have already signed up, including RN's, family members who have addicted children and other addicted family members. A free narcan kit is provided to each participant.
