## **New Business**

- Legislator Gerentine gave William Clark the floor. A discussion on the Family Court House ensued. Handouts were given to the committee. Topics included the following:
  - The additional judge given to the Ulster County Family Court.
  - A timetable of the current communications between the Executive office and the OCA
  - Where the county currently stands on a long term solution for family court.
  - The current items that need to be addressed in the current family court house that are needed to make it safe.
  - How the courthouses of the county are the responsibility of the county.
  - If the current facility is appropriately being maintained.
  - The new possible locations for the facilities, and the layout requirements for these locations.
  - The ramifications if no actions are taken including a second letter from the OCA, and a withholding of state funding.
  - A clarification that a majority of the dialogue has been between the OCA and the Executive office.
  - How the OCA feels that the current situation is not moving forward.
  - Reimbursement rates on the interest associated with the interest associated with the capital project.
  - The cost of current plans discussed.
  - How one of the potential new locations would require a public referendum.
  - How the county would have to wait to expend funds, with the exception of phase II, until the referendum is passed.
  - The current steps that would need to be taken in the short term to appease the OCA.
