Discussion: Legislator James Maloney suggested removing Management Non Union employees from the Resolution with the intent of discussing the benefits package for this employment classification at later date. Chairman Gerentine expressed concern that Ulster County Legislator salaries are already much lower than those of surrounding Counties and how this factor affects the County's ability to obtain qualified individuals for the positions. Legislator

Joseph Maloney argued that some union employees pay 20% towards their health care while Elected Officials and Management Non Union employees do not. Legislator Bartels, Legislator Archer, and Legislative Chairman Ronk expressed support for amending the Resolution to remove Management Non Union employees with the idea of elected officials leading by example. Discussion took place regarding compression issues which would be enhanced upon such change to Management Non Union employee benefits. Legislator Archer suggested subjecting the change for Management Non Union employees to a compensation study to ensure that individuals are being compensated appropriately. Legislator Nolan expressed concern, speaking in support to push for better coverage for all employees. Legislator Petit spoke in support of the Resolution, stating that someone else will fulfill the position if employees and elected officials are upset with the change. Nick Pascale, Legal Counsel, commented that the County's benefits manual will require revision if the Resolution is passed as is due to the effective date. Kyle Barnett, Legal Counsel, advised Committee members that the term "new hire" must be defined within the Resolution. Debate took place regarding the flow of information. Legislator Bartels requested circulation of all information Legislator Joseph Maloney possesses that was not previously shared with the Committee, requesting that the Resolution be postponed so that Committee members could review the information. Legislator Joseph Maloney agreed to circulate all information.

Further, Lieutenant Soule explained that the reader does record license plates, but its primary functions are to determine where there are speed problems and to record traffic data. Legislator Bartels voiced concern about the potential for license plate readers to violate privacy in terms of records retention, saying that she hopes to have this discussion in the future.

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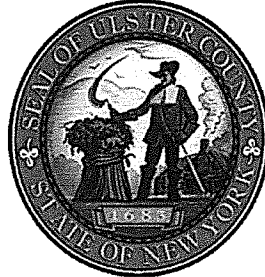

RE: Urging the Legislature to Support the Internet Fairness Conformity Tax

In the 2018-2019 New York State Executive Budget there is a provision that will require many **online retailers** to begin collecting sales taxes on purchases made by New York State residents, even if that online vendor has no physical presence or employees working in New York. Currently, the State does not collect certain internet-based sales tax and the Governor's Office is estimating that during the first full year of implementation, well over \$150 million could be returned to the counties.

I want to underscore that the proposal as explained in a recent Long Island News story, is "NOT A NEW TAX and DOES NOT INCREASE SALES TAXES. Rather, this proposal is a modernization to New York State's current sales tax collection procedures. New York residents legally owe the sales tax that would now be collected by online market places... The proposal allows New York State to adapt to the rapidly changing retail Internet economy by leveling the playing field for brick and mortar stores as online marketplaces continue to grow and expand."

Currently, Ulster County derives 36% of its revenues from sales tax, or a projected \$117 million, with a good portion of that being derived from the traditional brick and mortar retailers. As internet sales continue to pace at its 15% annual increase, traditional sales tax collection will be dramatically threatened. Sales tax revenue shortfalls would shift the burden on the 23% of the revenues collected from property tax, or worse yet, threaten to diminish the myriad of services that our County provides.

The mission of the Ulster County Comptroller's Office is to serve as an independent agency of the people, to protect the public interest by monitoring County government and to assess and report on the degree to which its operation is economical, efficient and its financial condition sound

This provision will level the sales tax playing field between New York retailers and the out-of-state Internet companies who exploited an unfair and unintended competitive advantage driven solely by physical presence or lack thereof. The president of the Retail Council of NYS summed it up concisely when he stated the “proposal is pro-Main Street, pro-business, pro-local government and pro-fairness.”

Three states (Washington, Colorado and Minnesota) already require on-line sales to collect sales tax. Our own New York State Association of Counties has gone on record supporting this.

Our State should join with them and reserve the right to collect sales tax on goods and services provided in a state, whether an out of state vendor supplies the goods or service is irrelevant because the destination of the good or service is the controlling entity for sales tax. This is a more efficient, modern, and fairer system of collecting sales tax owed under state law. It will provide critically important revenues for counties, towns, cities, villages and some school districts, and help local governments keep property taxes lower as the economy expands and progresses.

I am respectfully requesting that our Legislature consider a resolution in support of section AA of the Revenue Article VII Legislation contained in the State Budget that requires all marketplace providers to collect sales taxes and encourage our State representatives to support the same.
