Ulster County Legislature's Chairman David B. Donaldson along with Ulster County Sheriff Van Blarcum, jointly announces the formation of an Ulster Regional Gang Enforcement Narcotics Team (URGENT) task force. The forming of this task force is a great development for Ulster County Law Enforcement. Within our cities nationwide, gangs and narcotics are a threat to our quality of life and overall safety of our communities.

Chairman Donaldson believes that a task force effort of all agencies combating the same problem is the most efficient way to attack a problem. Gang violence and narcotics have been fought on many fronts within Ulster County but never battled in a comprehensive, coordinated manner the way this team will address the issues.

The combination of efforts from the Federal, State, County and local levels has not been fully realized by the residents of Ulster County dealing with these problems.
