Friends Of Hallie Arnold Create Memorial Tree Fund

In August 2006, Hallie Arnold, a former award winning reporter for the Daily Freeman and Director of Ulster County Tourism, died after a short, intense battle with lung cancer. Hallie was a talented musician, singer and quilter with a passion for animals and gardening. Prior to moving to Saugerties, Hallie resided in New Paltz where she maintained a plot at Gardens For Nutrition. In honor of her love of gardening, a group of friends and family members are raising funds for a white, flowering dogwood tree and memorial plaque to be placed in a park near Gardens For Nutrition on Huguenot Street. Donations are being sought for the project and a small dedication is planned for May 6, 2007, at a time yet to be finalized.

"I am pleased to support the efforts of Hallie Arnold's friends and family as they seek to create a lasting memorial to her through their tree fund. Given Hallie's love of the outdoors and gardening I find this to be a fitting and wonderful tribute to her life," said Ulster County Legislature Chairman David Donaldson, a cancer survivor.
