WHEREAS, the funding has been allocated by the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance to the Ulster County Department of Social Services as the local service district based upon a federal formula, and the funds will be used for some or all of the following key child support areas: paternity establishment, support order establishment, current collections, arrears collections and cost effectiveness, and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it
